APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

* Applicants meeting the following criteria are preferred, but all others will be considered.



For the following programs: Doctor of Pharmacy, Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine, Doctor of Physical Therapy, Master of Science in Public Health, Master of Science in Clinical Research, and Master of Science in Pharmaceutical Sciences

Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
(on a 4.0 scale)



For the Master of Physician Assistant Practice Program

Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.2
(on a 4.0 scale)
Completion of at least 75 credit hours
towards a Bachelor's Degree



Each program has additional qualifying information such as number of college course hours completed. Certain programs may also require the completion of specific science or math courses to apply.

What is HPREP?

HPREP (Health Professions Readiness & Enrichment Program) is an engaging four-day intensive summer training program offered at CPHS May 17-21, 2021. During this week, students are able to:

- Explore paths to various health care professions
- Receive education on career options, interviewing and application skills
- Participate in interactive learning sessions
- Build both a personal and professional network by meeting with our faculty and staff, along with student participants from across the nation!

- Discover how to become more competitive applicants for health profession admissions
- Learn how to improve or strengthen professional admission test taking skills through a PCAT, MCAT, and GRE review session
